



# The Importance Of Forgiveness

## THE IMPORTANCE OF FORGIVENESS

The basic law of this universe is the Law of Free Will. The basic purpose of life is to grow, to learn, to move on, to become more, to remember who we truly are—a son/daughter of God.

The thing that keeps us from growing, from moving on, is non-forgiveness. When we hold on to something that we have not forgiven, we are holding ourselves to a limited and imperfect sense of identity. We are essentially worshipping an idol of our own making.

By not forgiving, we take away our own freedom to move on. If we stay in one place too long, we stagnate. The negative energy forms around us and begins a downward pull. When it becomes too strong it overpowers our feelings and thoughts and we begin to believe there is no escape.

The Law of Free Will is an absolute law. There is no being in Heaven who is allowed to violate the free will of a human being. However there are dark forces in this world who are rebelling against God and God's laws. They have absolutely no respect for the free will of humans. They will violate and manipulate your free will for as long as you allow them to do so.

Because you have free will, you have the right to experiment with your creative abilities. You were created with the drive to experiment with God's laws and God's energies.

Your true identity is the spiritual self which actually resides in a higher realm of higher vibrations.

Unfortunately most people have lost contact with their spiritual selves and thus are locked in a lower state of consciousness of thinking they are separated from God.

People have accepted the **belief** that they are not responsible for their situation. People believe they have not created their current situation and because they didn't create it, there is nothing they can do to uncreate it.

They push aside all personal responsibility and feel there is nothing they could do to change the situation for the better. **This is a lie.**

Everything that is in the material universe is created from God energy. Remember the first words of Creation—“*Let there be light!*” God's energy is light, which is simply vibration, and no matter how low that vibration is, no matter how dense the physical matter might seem, it is always possible to raise the vibration of that energy and bring it back into alignment with the purity and perfection of God.

Science has proven that energy of a low frequency can be raised by bombarding it with energy of a higher frequency.

There is nothing that we can do or that any force could possibly do us, which cannot be undone and purified by the light and love of God.

Let me give you an illustration:

Imagine you go out at night with a flashlight. You hang the flashlight in a tree so the light beam is shining on the ground. Now imagine you have a bucket of mud and you start throwing the mud at the beam of light. Can you make the mud stick to the beam of light?

Science has told us that everything is made from energy. So the mud is simply a different form of energy than the beam of light. The mud has a much lower vibration than the light and because of that, it cannot cling to and pollute the light beam.

Your true identity is the spiritual self which actually resides in a higher realm of higher vibrations. Your soul was created to descend into the material realm, clothed in a physical body. So the idea that the soul could commit a sin that could permanently stain the spiritual self which resides in the spiritual realm, is as ridiculous as the idea that mud could cling to the beam of light.

The REAL you is that spiritual self!

Nothing you have ever done or could possibly do could pollute your spiritual self. You are as pure and worthy of God's love as the day you were created. Nothing you have ever done has made you unworthy of God's love

The forces of darkness want you to think that because you have done this or that, you are no longer worthy of God's love. So you begin to believe that lie and think you

need to hide from God and there is no point in asking for forgiveness.

So the thinking that keeps you trapped in your current state of consciousness is that you won't accept God's forgiveness. He forgives immediately as you accept the idea that you have chosen to think incorrectly.

Actually, he doesn't need to forgive—he still sees you as wonderfully pure and worthy of his love.

Why won't you accept that you are forgiven?

According to the Law of Free Will, you have a right to create anything you want. If you create a false image of yourself, you can become trapped in that identity. You are worshipping a false image.

The only way you can overcome that limitation, which is only in your mind, is to decide you no longer want to be that way. You must be WILLING to let go of those thoughts of your false identity. You want to let go of those limitations and move on.

But how do you let go of those limitations? You do it by forgiving yourself for creating those limitations in the first place. Only as you recognize that **you made up** the thoughts—created the limitations—not God, not the person who did whatever to you—not even Lucifer and his henchmen.

You created the situation, but God does not condemn you for doing so. So there is no reason for you to condemn yourself.

Ultimately, non-forgiveness of your self is a sign of PRIDE and arrogance. If God forgives you, then how can you feel you are better than God? You're not forgiving what God IS forgiving. That is rebellion and pride.

The material universe is created from energies that are quite dense. There are different levels of energy vibration in the material world. Remember how a prism breaks sunlight into different colors? Those are different energy vibrations or frequencies. The Universe also has different frequencies of energy vibration.

So everything created in the matter universe started as an **idea** in the etheric realm. It was then solidified as a **thought** in the mental realm. It received energy and motion in the emotional realm, before it finally broke through into the material realm.

(Does this sound familiar? It is the very process of the Law of Attraction. Your desire starts out as an idea, then solidifies as a thought, you give it emotion and desire and eventually it breaks through into the material realm.)

This is why our circumstances do not change overnight. It takes some time. To change circumstances in the physical world, you need to go to the source.

You begin by changing the images in the etheric world—the ideas, the sense of your identity. That begins to change the thoughts and feelings and finally cycles into

the physical realm. Realize that it takes some time for the densest energies to materialize into physical existence.

This is why the only way to change your outer circumstances is to begin by changing your inner circumstances—your state of consciousness.

### Stop the blaming game

If you're experiencing situations you don't like, instead of blaming God, other people or even yourself, you need to stop the blaming game. You need to forgive yourself and say, *"I did an experiment that didn't work out the way I intended. So I'm going to leave that experiment and come up higher in consciousness."* You need to take the steps to change your experience and learn from it and create a better one.

You have probably heard what Thomas Edison said when asked how he felt failing hundreds of times to make a light bulb work. "I didn't fail a thousand times, I learned a thousand ways that didn't work."

When he tried copper as the filament for the light bulb and it didn't work, he simply threw the copper away and never used it again. He left behind the idea that copper would ever produce light. He didn't insist on keeping the materials from his failed experiments cluttering up his laboratory until he could barely move around. He simply threw away what didn't work and moved on, trying something new until he found something that worked.

You must never stop experimenting. It was our free will and desire to experiment that led us to fall from the Garden of Eden, but at the same time, it is only our drive to experiment that will lead us back to the oneness with God.

Our souls are the vehicles for experiencing this world through imagination and free will. By using those faculties we add to our sense of identity. What causes the soul to become trapped in the material world is a LIMITED sense of identity. That limited sense of identity is the result of an experiment with undesirable consequences. You don't have to keep on believing in that limited identity.

Yet the only thing that can help the soul escape its prison is to continue experimenting until we find the higher identity of being in a state of grace—knowing that we are worthy in the eyes of God, because we identify ourselves as sons and daughters of God.

The key to freedom from your current limitations is to forgive all who played a role in creating those limitations.

The Bible says, "*Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.*" (Romans 12:19) The truth behind that statement is that God created an impersonal law—the law of karma, which makes sure no soul will ever escape the consequences of its uses or misuses of God's energy.

Therefore you do not need to become angry at those who harm you. No matter what they do to you, they cannot harm your soul, they cannot harm your true identity—you

are a spiritual being. You rise above it when you realize they are simply throwing mud at the light beam of your soul. The mud has no power to cling to the true light that you are.

You will be free of imperfections and limitations only when you fully accept that you are free, only when you fully forgive yourself and accept your true identity as a spiritual being who has never been touched by anything in this world.

In reality, you ARE a spiritual being, but at the level of your soul, you are who you THINK you are. Stop thinking you are an imperfect being and accept your true identity as a spiritual being.
